Religious Education

Reconciliation: Living in a Forgiving Community

In this module students will explore the human experiences of forgiving and being forgiven. The module introduces students to the Sacrament of Penance where we celebrate our reconciliation with God and one another. Students will describe how their choices affect their relationships with God and others. This module is designed to support the Parish Sacramental Program for First Reconciliation. Lent and Easter are incorporated in the module.

Religious Education activities will also include formal and informal prayers, liturgies, class celebrations and Bible reading of scripture stories. The Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist will be focal points throughout the year.
