CONSENT FOR VIEWING OF SELECTED FILMS

From time to time classes need to view films to support their learning program. On occasions some films are found to be classified PG. Examples of these films are the Roald Dahl stories, the Chronicles of Narnia by CS Lewis and My Place by Nadia Wheatley. The definition of PG classification is printed below.

Any films classified PG would only be used in grades 3 to 6. These films would be previewed by the class teachers to ensure that they are appropriate to the class learning program.

If you are satisfied that suitable supervision and guidance will be given to your child should a PG film be required to be viewed by your child's class.

Parental Guidance (PG)
